



ASHA POLICY FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF NEWLY PURCHASED JOG CART AND RACE BIKE DAMAGE CLAIMS (REVISED MAY 1, 2007)

EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2007

RACE BIKES: NEW PURCHASES

Effective May 1, 2007, to qualify for full benefits under this policy, new purchases are required to be registered with identifying numbers with the ASHA office within 14 days of purchase and delivery. If a new purchase is not so registered with the ASHA office, any future claim(s) for that bike may be reimbursed at a value determined by a designated ASHA representative and reimbursement will be calculated on that assessed value.

The damage being claimed, the value of the claim and the general condition of the bike must be verified and approved by the designated ASHA representative.

All claims for reimbursement must be supported by legitimate receipts detailing the nature and cost of the repairs.

All claims for damage repairs on new purchases will be subject to a deductible of \$100 on all claims with the maximum amount payable as reimbursement on any one claim to be \$1500, less the \$100 deductible.

The value of a new purchase will be depreciated by 20% per year on a straight line basis. At the end of year 5, a bike will be considered to have no value and claims will not be accepted.

RACE BIKES: USED EQUIPMENT

Older equipment, equipment poorly maintained, equipment in questionable condition or considered unsafe or unsuitable for use will be evaluated for the appropriateness of the repair or replacement claim. Claims for repairs or replacement of race bikes that have been in use will not automatically qualify for a full or partial reimbursement of the claim until the claim is assessed and approved by an ASHA representative.

JOGGING CARTS: NEW PURCHASES

Effective May 1, 2007, to qualify for full benefits under this policy, it is advised that new purchases be registered with the ASHA office within 14 days of purchase and delivery. If a new purchase is not so registered with the ASHA office, any future claim(s) for that bike may be reimbursed at a value determined by a designated ASHA representative and reimbursement will be calculated on that assessed value.

The damage being claimed, the value of the claim and the general condition of the cart must be verified and approved by the designated ASHA representative.

All claims for reimbursement must be supported by legitimate receipts detailing the nature and cost of the repairs.

All claims for damage repairs on new purchases will be subject to a deductible of \$100 on all claims with the maximum amount payable as reimbursement on any one claim to be \$750, less the \$100 deductible.

JOGGING CARTS: USED EQUIPMENT

Older equipment, equipment poorly maintained, equipment in questionable condition or considered unsafe or unsuitable for use will be evaluated for the appropriateness of the repair or replacement claim. Claims for repairs or replacement of race bikes that have been in use will not automatically qualify for a full or partial reimbursement of the claim until the claim is assessed and approved by an ASHA representative.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

The maximum amount payable to any one trainer in a twelve month period, for race bikes, jogging carts or any combination thereof, regardless of the number of claims and the amounts claimed will be \$2,050.00, after deductibles.

Claims for reimbursement must be for a single bike or cart. Bikes and/or carts may not be combined in the same claim.
