ASHA Yearling Sale – Policy regarding the withdrawal of
an entry from the sale.
Effective February 25, 2006

Withdrawal Policy and Procedure

A sale entry withdrawn from the sale after the consignor has received the consignor's sale package may only be withdrawn from the sale with a certificate issued by an ASHA assigned veterinarian.

The consignor's sale package, including stall allocation, hip number(s) and pedigree sheets for entries will only be provided to the consignor after registration papers and a signed transfer are provided to the sale office. For entries that are electronically registered, the sale office must be provided with a signed transfer.

1. A Withdrawal Policy will be in effect for the 2007 sale. Yearlings withdrawn from the sale after the consignor has received the consignor's sale package may only be withdrawn from the sale with a certificate issued by an ASHA assigned veterinarian. Sales Stakes eligibility may be maintained under this option with a payment equaling 5% of the average sale price, paid within seven days of the sale conclusion. A separate withdrawal fee of \$1500.00 will apply if this ASHA veterinarian certificate is not obtained.
