HRA report

The gross slot revenue was approximately \$ 50,000 over budget for the month of October. Other revenues and expenses were close to the budgeted amounts.

Cash flow is on budget at the end of October. Purse support for 2022 is projected at \$12,500,000 and BIP is projected at \$ 3,400,000. HRA does not anticipate any reductions in these amounts unless the Casino's are closed again in 2022.

Warrior Relay Racing (WRR) is generating a lot of interest from the racetracks and government. HRA had a discussion with Max Gibb regarding WRR. A committee of HRA has been formed to review WRR and what position HRA needs to have

The purse support allocation between the breeds has been approved for 2022. It is anticipated the purse allocation for 2023 to 2026 will be approved at the January HRA board meeting

Bobby Allen requested a racing licence and the transfer of 100 slot machined form Stampede Park to run a thoroughbred meet at Stampede Park from January to April 2022. The request for a racing licence was denied.

A new process for rule changes was approved. It is anticipated that the rules will only be changed once per year in the spring. There will be exemptions for emergency rule changes. The application form and instructions for a rule change are on the HRA website
